We really appreciate your help and quick response!

We are grateful for the prompt decision of the European veterinary Commission regarding refugee animals. It has no doubt saved thousands of lives!

We are grateful to our closest neighbors from Poland, who extended a helping hand on all fronts. We are grateful to our colleagues from the Baltic States for their big hearts and willingness to help. We are very grateful to the responding colleagues from Bulgaria, Romania, Slovakia and Ireland. We have begun to make a list of colleagues who are ready to help, but we are sure that in stress we have missed many who have already written. I kindly ask you to write to Natalia Ignatenko contact and country if you are not on this list. The list is attached below. We carry everyone in it and publish it on the USAVA page.

We are very grateful to the Laboklin laboratory, which generously agreed to do a free titer of antibodies to rabies for animals coming from Ukraine. If each of the associations can send us lists of clinics where refugees and their patients can be sent for first aid, clinical examination and determination of rabies antibody titer, this would be a great support for us.

If in every country you allow refugees to provide first aid to their animals and you need measures to legalize the phones and websites of the association, to coordinate people on the ground, this would help us a lot.

To date, the Akana company has been providing assistance with free food for two days, and today the Royal Canin company also promised to help shelters in the Dnieper. We really appreciate and very much look forward to the help of other companies.

We wrote to the Hills company, we really hope that they will be able to transfer help to us through colleagues from the Czech Republic or Slovakia.

We are very grateful to the transport from Lithuania, which carries three minibuses with food to the border.

We are very grateful to our colleagues on all borders with Ukraine, who help people with animals day and night!

But in Kyiv, a large number of animals remain in shelters that cannot leave. We are trying to compile lists of those shelters that need help. We will be grateful for financial donations. We leave the details below.
